

PKS Kids Grant Application Guidelines

One of the purposes of the PKS Kids organization is to provide emotional, medical and other resources and support to families of children with Pallister-Killian Syndrome. In support of this purpose, PKS Kids shall, from time to time, take applications for and award grants to eligible recipients according to the following guidelines:

1. Grant applications are only accepted for specific equipment, medical, or therapy needs, or such items or services as the Board determines appropriate. The Board reserves sole discretion to approve or disprove any requested item or service funded pursuant to the PKS Kids grant program.
2. Applications must be submitted on the PKS Kids Grant Application Form attached.
3. Payments will be made directly to the licensed equipment company or service provider, not to the individual or family.
4. Grant applications will be accepted only for children diagnosed with PKS.
5. Applications will be accepted without regard to race, national origin, ethnic background, sex, or religion.
6. Please be as specific as possible regarding the details of the requested grant funds.
7. The child must be a full time resident in the home, and a citizen of the United States or a legal resident.
8. Grant applications will be accepted from parents, foster parents, or adoptive parents and will be evaluated on an individual basis by the PKS Kids grant making committee according to objective criteria established by the board of directors.
9. Grant funds will not exceed \$1000 per recipient.
10. Recipients will be solely responsible for any tax liability and reporting associated with receipt of the grant funds.
11. Recipients will be responsible for reporting grant funds to public assistance agencies where applicable. PKS Kids shall not be responsible for any reduction in public assistance benefits as a result of grants received.
12. PKS Kids reserves the right to request follow-up documentation or reports regarding use of grants funds.

13. The number and size of grants may vary from year to year and are subject to the available resources and annual budget of PKS Kids.
14. PKS Kids may establish and revise application dates and deadlines from time to time. Application dates and deadlines will be posted on the PKS Kids website or otherwise publicized to prospective applicants.
15. All grants shall be subject to the terms and conditions of the PKS Kids Bylaws including the Conflict of Interest Policy. PKS Kids grantmaking activities shall comply with all statutes and regulations applicable to organizations exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
